



GENITAL HERPES

Daily Therapy* 1 g QD or 500 mg[†] QD

Daily Therapy in HIV+ Adults 500 mg BID

Initial Therapy* 1 g BID x 10 days

Episodic Therapy* 500 mg BID x 3 days

OTHER INDICATIONS

Cold Sores* 2 g BID x 1 day

Herpes Zoster* 1 g TID x 7 days

*In healthy adults.

No data are available on the efficacy of treatment of more than one year's duration (for suppression), started more than 72 hours (for initial), or more than 24 hours (for episodic) after onset of signs or symptoms, started after the development of clinical signs of a cold sore, or started more than 72 hours after rash onset (for herpes zoster).

Dosage adjustments should be made in patients with varying degrees of renal dysfunction. Please refer to the recommended dosing adjustments in the Prescribing Information for VALTREX.

[†] Recommended dosage is 1 g QD. In patients with ≤ 9 recurrences a year, an alternate dosage is 500 mg QD.

Important Prescribing, Dosing, and Safety Information:

The efficacy of VALTRESX has not been established when treatment is initiated after the development of clinical signs (eg, papule, vesicle, or ulcer) of a cold sore. Treatment should not exceed 1 day. Therapy beyond 1 day does not provide additional clinical benefit.

The safety and efficacy of VALTRESX for suppression of recurrent genital herpes in patients with advanced HIV disease (CD4 cell count <100 cells/mm³) have not been established. The efficacy of VALTRESX for the episodic treatment of genital herpes in HIV+ patients has not been established. No data are available for the use of suppression in HIV+ patients beyond 6 months.

WARNING: Thrombotic thrombocytopenic purpura/hemolytic uremic syndrome (TTP/HUS), in some cases resulting in death, has occurred in patients with advanced HIV disease and also in allogeneic bone marrow transplant and renal transplant recipients participating in clinical trials of VALTRESX at doses of 8 g per day.
